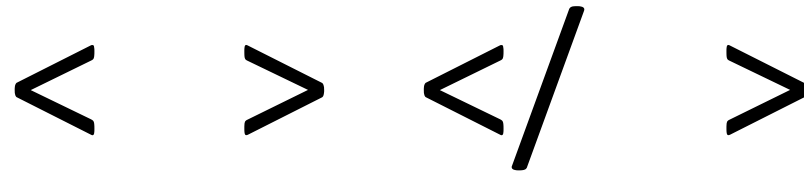

HTML what is it ...



HTML is a tag language that tells web browsers such as Firefox, Chrome or Internet Explorer to show web pages. It is very easy to use and you only need to know a few tags to code a simple web page.

HTML Code



Basic Tags



`<html>` `</html>`

Creates an HTML document

`<head>` `</head>`

Sets off the title and other information that isn't displayed on the web page itself

`<body>` `</body>`

Sets off the visible portion of the document

Inserting spaces...

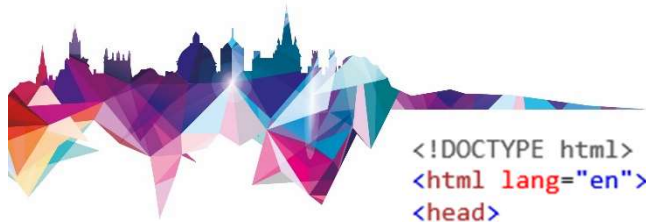

Tables



`<table></table>` - Creates a table

`<tr></tr>` - Sets off each row in a table

`<td></td>` - Sets off each cell in a row

`<th></th>` - Sets off the table header (a normal cell with bold, centred text)

Ordered Lists



Ordered Lists

```
<ol>  
<li>This is the first</li>  
<li>This is the second</li>  
<li>This is the third</li>  
</ol>
```

Result →

1. This is the first
2. This is the second
3. This is the third

Unordered Lists

```
<ul>  
<li>Here is the first</li>  
<li>Here is the second</li>  
<li>Here is the third</li>  
</ul>
```

Result →

- Here is the first
- Here is the second
- Here is the third

Dos and don'ts of editing HTML...



Do:

- find code and edit, rather than writing it from scratch
- use an HTML Checker to check your edits
- use Notepad or Notepad++ when copying HTML code

Don't:

- use Word to edit your HTML code or for copying code
